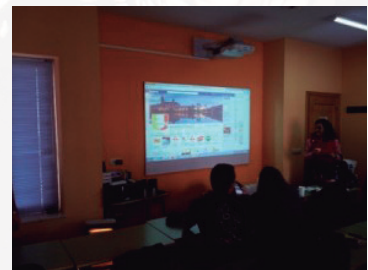
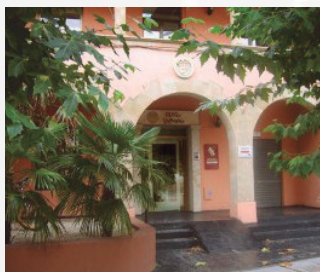
Spanish Courses Unamuno receives annually an average of 900 students. The average of students in the school is usually about 70 more or less. But this number tends to vary depending on the month, with an average of 40-50 usually in the months of lowest attendance (October to December) and 80-90 in the months of further assistance (February to August).

The class composition is varied, because we have pupils aged between 15 and 65 years, and they come almost from all over the world, throughout the year, especially from Europe: Germany, Austria, France, Italy, Portugal, Russia ... and from America: Brazil, United States, Mexico and Puerto Rico.

## Enrollment

Enrollment 40 euros per person. Includes: visit to the city, dossier, transfer service from train or bus station in Salamanca, student card, diploma and certificates.

## Cancellation and delays

If for any reason you have to cancel your trip to Salamanca, please call or contact by FAX or MAIL at least two weeks before the beginning of the course. We will keep you reservation for the next 6 months.

If you notify later, your enrollment fee will not be refunded.

After the first day of class, you will not be able to cancel the dates of the course. This general condition will apply whether you have attended the course or not.

If your trip is delayed, you should contact the administration at least a week in advance. If we do not receive notification, your reservation for both the course and accommodation will be cancelled.

# SPECIFIC COURSES

## MEDICAL COURSE WITH INTERNSHIPS

This course aims to meet the growing need and demand for the teaching of Spanish for specific purposes, in this case focused on the field of medicine. Throughout the course "Medical Spanish" we combine specific content with purely grammatical content. In this course, students and health-care professionals develop understanding and communication in real situations in their work environment, they learn the basic vocabulary related to medicine, they study grammatical structures and basic functions and they become familiar with the Spanish social system and health.

Some of the **OBJECTIVES** of this course are:

- Writing histories and Prepare diagnoses.
- Distinguish formal and informal register.
- Knowing the specific vocabulary and increase common vocabulary.
- Defining symptoms and Distinguish diseases.
- Knowing the system and operation of health in Spain.
- Possess skills to react appropriately in different health care in Spain.

### IMPORTANT: INTERNSHIPS

This course includes supervised internships by a medical team in the different health specialties at different Salamanca hospitals.

## SPANISH + BUSINESS INTERNSHIPS

The Spanish course of business will be mainly practical, the student will study real cases and he will recreate communication situations specific to the field of business. Different techniques will be used to improve the communicative competence of the student and tools for self-learning will be given.

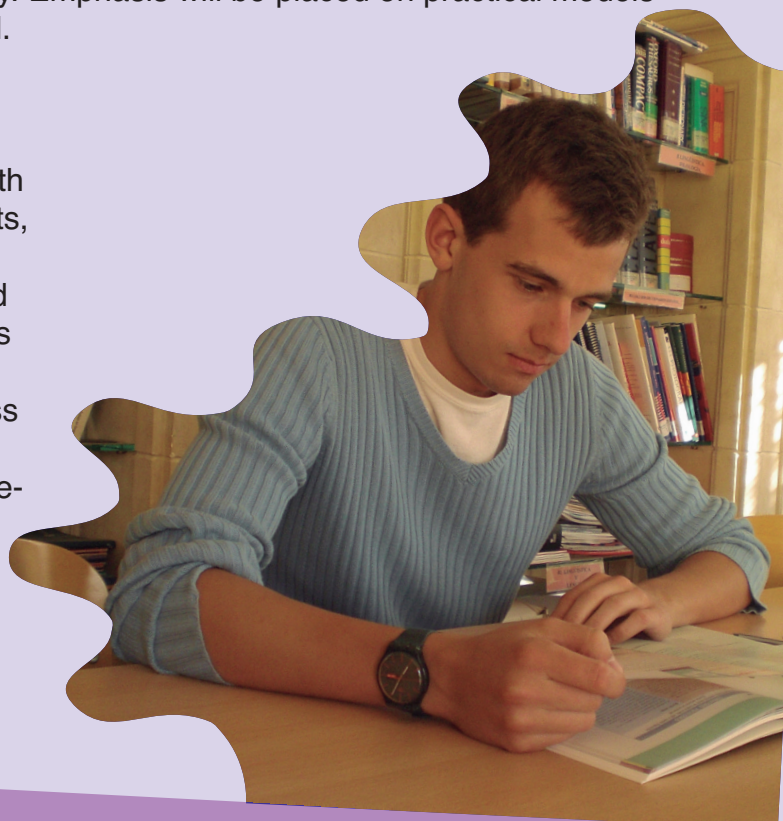


## LEGAL SPANISH COURSE

- Acquire the vocabulary of the specific field.
